Bids will be received until 2:00 p.m., September 29 2010, at which time they will be opened and read aloud.

All bids must be in sealed envelope with bidders name and address on outside and marked bid on "Inspection and Clean-out of Water Storage Tanks."

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to accept the bid most favorable to the City.

## SPECIFICATIONS

Inspection will include video and full inspection report as to the integrity and overall condition of the tank. Inspection report must conform to all rules and regulations set forth by the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, pertaining to five (5) year inspections of Potable Water Storage Tanks.

Clean-out will involve cleaning of silt in the bottom of tanks and will include dechlorination of discharge water, plus the use of silt bags to capture silt.

All tanks will be in use and will not be taken out of service at the time of inspection and clean-out.

Attachment includes size and dimensions of the four (4) tanks.
