

Jake Thomas Road Closure Notice September 21-28, 2014

Jake Thomas Road will be closed to general traffic beginning Sunday, September 21, 2014 2:00 P.M. through Sunday, September 28, 2014 1:00 A.M. This section of Jake Thomas Road between Walgreen's entrance and Teaster Lane will close in order to accommodate hotel shuttles, trolleys and motor coach loading and unloading for the National Quartet Convention.

Please alert your guests who are attending NQC events at the LeConte Center that they may enter Teaster Lane from the following Traffic Lights # 2A, #3, Island Drive Light, #7, or #8 to access parking at:

- LeConte Center Municipal Parking 2986 Teaster Lane
- Pigeon River Crossings 2655 Teaster Lane



If your property has motor coaches staying at your property, please alert them that they will be allowed to enter Jake Thomas Road from Teaster Lane for loading and unloading by way of Teaster Lane.

- Please alert your guests that overflow parking at the LeConte Center at Pigeon Forge and additional parking for NQC visitors with Free shuttle service are at the following locations:
 - Pigeon River Crossings 2655 Teaster Lane
 - Dollywood's Splash Country Parking Lot 2700 Dollywood Parks Blvd
- No pets, outside food or drinks are allowed to enter the LeConte Center at Pigeon Forge. Food and concessions are available for purchase inside the facility.
- Please alert your guests who are attending NQC events at the LeConte Center that Jake Thomas Road will be closed and that they can enter Teaster Lane from the following Traffic Lights # 2A, #3, Island Drive Light, #7, or #8 to access parking at:
 - LeConte Center Municipal Parking 2986 Teaster Lane
 - Pigeon River Crossings 2655 Teaster Lane

- Special Trolley Routes have been established for pick-up on the Parkway for the duration of the show. These trolleys will be labeled "LeConte Center Shuttle".

- Trolley passes for multiple days will be available in the NQC registration area at the LeConte Center at Pigeon Forge or they may go online to NQConline.com and purchase the pass. (Limited quantities are available)
- Trolleys will begin running NQC routes on Sunday at 3:00 P.M. and Monday Saturday at 8:00 A.M. and the last trolley to depart from the LeConte Center after the evening events will be 1:00 A.M.
